Job Title: Associate Student Minister (Midweek/Creative)

Department: Ministerial Staff/Student Ministry

Reports To: Pastor- Waypoint Students

FLSA Status: Full time

SUMMARY: The associate student minister, in collaboration with the student pastor and student ministry staff team, will be responsible for providing leadership and oversight to a number of significant areas in Waypoint Students, including, but not limited to, all aspects of life groups, creative content, and midweek services.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- In collaboration with the student pastor and student ministry staff, oversee the planning and execution of all
 aspects of the Waypoint Students midweeks services. This includes all aspects of serving planning, team
 coordination (internal and external), leader preparation and equipping, and the execution of weekly student
 services.
- Participate in the strategic planning and vision casting process of Waypoint Students under the leadership of the student pastor. This includes discipleship of students, leaders, and parents.
- Recruit, equip, and provide ongoing support and direction to all levels of leaders within the student ministry (volunteers, students, parents, etc)
- Develop a regular rhythm of meeting with life group and midweek mentors to provide ongoing care, support, training, and encouragement.
- Ensure that clear and easily accessible feedback loops are in place for all leaders serving in any aspect of life groups or midweek services.
- Provide oversight for all aspects of the Waypoint Students creative needs including social media accounts and the
 design and development of student, parent, and/or leader resources (ie-books for The WKND, Summer Camp,
 etc)
- In collaboration with the student ministry team, develop and execute a system of care for leaders, students, and parents that takes into account aspects such as feedback loops, meeting rhythms, equipping and communication, and crisis care responses.
- In conjunction with the student pastor and the student ministry team, develop a plan for providing dynamic content on social media platforms
- At the discretion and request of the student pastor, serve as a communicator at student ministry events.
- Engage with students and leaders by attending events and gatherings outside of the normal church rhythms. This can include concerts, recitals, competitions, sports, etc.
- In collaboration with the student pastor and student ministry team, develop and manage the Waypoint Students budget.
- Participate in all student ministry events, trips, camps, etc.
- Other duties as assigned by the student pastor.
